GARRETT PAVING CO. INC. WINS TOP AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN ASPHALT PAVING

Greenbelt, Md. — The National Asphalt Pavement Association (NAPA) announced today that Garrett Paving Co. Inc. of Athens, Ga., won a 2019 Larry H. Lemon Quality in Construction Award for excellence in construction of an asphalt pavement. The company received its award today at a ceremony during the association's 65th Annual Meeting in Maui, Hawaii.

The Larry H. Lemon Quality in Construction Award recognizes the 10 highest-scoring projects submitted for a Quality in Construction Award in the General Paving (less than 50,000 tons) category. The award is sponsored by *Asphalt Contractor* magazine.
